Our Chapter supplied the food for the families and that was a major undertaking! We shopped at Aldi's again this year, and they were most cooperative. Bobbie called in the order. The manager at the Aldi's on Five and Twenty here in Canandaigua responded beautifully. She and her crew pulled all the items, called, and went over the list again to make sure they had everything, loaded it onto flat carts then muscled it into our vehicles and away we went! Our deepest thanks to the staff at Aldi's for their wonderful assistance.

Of course, it was raining heavily on delivery day. Brian and Paul, a Blue Star Rider who luckily had a trailer, unloaded the boxes into the back door of the Canteen where Bobbie, myself, Nancy Bardeen and her two incredible grandchildren, Max and Sadie, as well as Joanne Acquilano and Linda Green, formed a fire line and stacked it all in the living room. Then we lined up the boxes out on the porch and sorted all the goods into the boxes. Nobody was doing anything strenuous after that little adventure! Bobbie went to get produce at the Public Market while Brian and I picked up the perishable stuff at Aldi's. Joanne co-opted her brother, Doug, and two of his three boys, plus Nancy and Max, once again, to sort 500 pounds of potatoes, 250 pounds of carrots, onions, celery, bananas, and squash into bags to help fill the boxes.
