Date & place to drop off will be announced via email.

Jen Cratsley, a Gold Star Wife and a new member of NY Chapter One is starting a Gold Star Wives of America, Inc. Chapter and the dedication will be on April 9, 2022.

A Church group, that has a prayer shawl committee, will knit hats, gloves and mittens for our Veterans.

At our November 13, 2021 meeting We will pack Christmas boxes for our NATO unit.
